Baby Puppy Dog

1st Murphy's Taleyah What's It All About

Quality pale boy of excellent bone and substance. Very balanced with straight front, neat feet, good forehand construction, level topline, correct tailset, good bend of stifle and well let down hocks. Lovely head with dark eye and pleasing expression. Good coat. Super temperament and character and moved out well for such a baby.

Minor Puppy Dog

1st Mitchell's Kiriel Highland Laddie

Larger framed mid gold boy of good balance but, understandably at this age, very raw. Good bone with straight front and neat feet, pleasing head with super dark eye and good pigmentation. Adequate forehand angulation with good length of rib, level topline and good bend of stifle. Moved out with enthusiasm if a little exuberant and erratic. Lovely temperament.

Puppy Dog

1st Middleton/Salvestrin's Fantango Double Take

Quality pale boy well up to size with a pleasing outline. Lovely dark eye and pigmentation with well set ears giving a pleasing expression. Good depth of chest and neat feet. Good length of upper arm although would prefer a little more layback of shoulder. Good length of rib, level topline and correct tailset with lovely bend of stifle and well let down hocks. Moved out very stylishly in profile but pinning a little on return - just needs to tighten up a little in front as is often the case with a youngster. Shown in beautiful coat with excellent presentation.

Junior Dog

1st Goldshyne Kennels' Goldshyne My Style

Pale dog of good size and balance. Straight front standing with lovely head, expressive dark eye and good pigmentation combining to present a very pleasing expression. Adequate forehand angulation with good depth of chest, good length and spring of rib, level topline and correct tailset. Well let down hocks, shown in good coat of correct texture and in good condition. Stylish in profile on the move but a little lose in front. Well presented and handled. **Best Junior**

2nd Wallis' Boolaroo Hillbilly

Lovely mid gold type of good size and balance. Strong head with dark eye, good pigmentation and correct earset. Straight legs but standing a little out at elbow with balanced angulation front and back and good spring of rib although would prefer a little more length. Level topline and correct tailset. Moved out very nicely when he hit his stride. Well presented.

Intermediate Dog

Very close between these two.

1st Thompson's Ch Chaleur You Had Me At Hello (AI)

Well balanced pale boy of excellent quality. Well proportioned head with dark eye, good pigmentation and pleasing expression. Good depth of brisket and very good forechest, adequate forehand angulation with level topline, correct tailset, good bend of stifle and well let down hocks. Moved out well in profile but a little loose in front and close behind today. Very well presented. **Best Intermediate**

2nd Stapylton's Ch Giltedge Hans Solo

Liked this boy very much. Another of good size and balance with very pleasing head, dark eye and good pigmentation. Straight front with neat feet, good length of upper arm and layback of blade with level topline, good spring of rib, lovely bend of stifle and well let down hocks. Moving close behind but lovely in profile. Shown in good condition.

State Bred Dog

1st Thompson's Ch Chaleur Say I Will (AI)

Another good sized, well balanced boy of excellent quality. Good head proportions with dark eye and pleasing expression. Good depth of chest with good forechest and forehand construction. Level topline with good spring of rib - although would prefer a little more length - and correct tailset. Strong over the loin with lovely width of thigh, good bend of stifle and well let down hocks.

Movement away and back could be tightened up. Shown in good coat of correct texture. Well presented.

Australian Bred Dog

1st Handley/Stephen's Ch Giltedge Do You Like Apples (AI)

Lovely type - mid gold, mature, well balanced boy with lovely head and correct earset. Straight front with good feet, good depth of chest and pleasing forehand construction. Good length and spring of rib, level topline, correct tailset and well let down hocks with good width of thigh and bend of stifle. Well presented and shown in full coat. Moved correctly away and back and with accurate footfall in profile although a little more reach and drive would have completed the picture and cost him in the challenge for Best Exhibit In Show.

Challenge Dog, Best Australian Bred, Best Opposite in Show and Runner Up Best In Show.

2nd Ohlrich's Ch Piarki Winstons Golden Ticket

Another lovely type with similar comments applying but slightly less substance and lacking a little in maturity which is understandable given the difference in ages between them. Good head with dark eye and pleasing, kindly expression. Pleasing forehand construction with level topline and adequate bend of stifle. Moved out very well in profile. Shown in well presented coat and good condition.

Open Dog

1st Thompson's Sup Ch Chaleur Hilfiger

Super quality pale boy of good size with excellent bone and substance and neat feet. Pleasing head with dark eye and kindly expression. A shade more length in neck would just complete the picture but good length of upper arm and adequate layback of blade, level topline, correct tailset, well sprung rib and lovely sweep of stifle. Carrying the correct amount of weight and moved out well with plenty of drive.

2nd Reimann's Bournbeau My Jasperson Angus CD

Loved this boy for his breed type and balance although not a big lad. Lovely head, eye and expression with straight front and balanced angulation front and rear, good depth of chest, well sprung rib and correct tailset. Well presented in full, lovely rich golden coat of correct texture. Very sound away and back and steady in profile but a little heavy for me today.

Veteran Dog

Two cracking veterans. Liked them both very much and thank their owners for affording me the opportunity to judge them.

1st Murphy's Ch Baradav Murphy's Law (AI)

Loved this boy for his old fashioned type and lovely outline with nothing overdone, everything flowing and so easy in his stance. So much to like.

Good bone and substance with lovely head and eye and the gentlest of expressions. Straight front with good depth of brisket and good forechest. Good reach of neck and probably the best forehand construction of the males today. Good spring and length of rib and strong over the loin with correct tailset and firm, level topline held on the move. Super width of thigh and bend of stifle with well let down hocks. Shown in full coat of correct texture with no unnecessary trimming. Moved correctly away and back and so steady and stylish in profile with easy reach and drive. Lovely temperament with plenty of character. Belied his age and a well deserved winner of the **Reserve Challenge Dog and Best Veteran in Show** awards. A credit to his owner.

2nd Thompson's Ch Dewmist Highway Of Hope (Imp Sweden)

Another lovely boy of good size and balance. Good head proportions with dark eye and kindly expression. Good length of neck into pleasing forehand construction with good depth of chest and good spring and length of rib. Level topline and correct tailset with lovely bend of stifle and well let down hocks. Moved correctly and pressed hard but not quite the drive of (1) today. Well presented and well handled.

Neuter Dog

1st Wills' Neut Ch Savaneta Light The Way (AI) CCD RN

Well up to size but carrying no weight. Good head proportions with good length of neck and straight front. Lacked a little depth but balanced angulation fore and aft and moved out truly and with some ease. Lovely temperament and well presented.

Baby Puppy Bitch

Two little crackers to start off the bitch judging!

1st Wallis' Boolaroo Sea Biscuit

Very good quality baby with excellent bone and substance. Feminine head with dark eye, good pigmentation and pleasing expression. Straight front with neat feet and already some depth. Well constructed all through with balanced angulation fore and aft, level topline, correct tailset and well let down hocks. Moved correctly away and back and very pleasing in profile. Shown in good coat. Well presented and handled. **Best Baby Puppy**

2nd Steaphens/Platt Fetchnpoint Roll The Dice

Very balanced mid gold baby with super clean outline. Feminine head with lovely eye shape and colour and good pigmentation contributing to a very pleasing expression. Well constructed both ends. Moved correctly away and back and, although not quite holding her topline on the move, moved out happily. Lovely temperament and sympathetically handled.

Minor Puppy Bitch

1st Paterson's Fernfall Summer Rains

Very well balanced and 'together' for a youngster with clean, balanced outline. Pretty, feminine head with dark eye and pleasing expression. Straight front, neat feet, good depth of chest with good length of neck into lovely forehand construction. Level topline and correct tailset with lovely width of thigh, good bend of stifle and well let down hocks. Moved correctly away and back and very steadily in profile. Lovely coat and condition, well presented and handled. **Best Minor Puppy**

2nd Bourn's Bournbeau Blair In Tartan

Very different in type to (1) with quite a large frame but not overdone in any way and very balanced presenting a super, clean outline. Straight front and neatest of feet with balanced head proportions and a kindly expression. Plenty of time for rib to spring and just a little raw all through so will take time to fill out her frame. Moved out nicely and shown in a well presented beautiful rich golden coat. Sound temperament. Well handled.

3rd Bing's Goldverlia Aurora Skylar

Super quality pale bitch but not enjoying her day out. Pleasing construction with good angulation both ends. Lovely head, dark eye and pleasing expression with super dark points. Straight front, correct tailset and well let down hocks. Moved correctly but a little apprehensive today.

Res MacDonald's Morningmyst Reason To Believe (AI)

Large framed dark girl with straight front and neat feet. Good length of upper arm but would prefer slightly more layback of blade. Will take some time to deepen. Moved ok behind and very easy on the move but not holding her topline in profile today.

Puppy Bitch

Very close between these two.

1st Hodges' Camuka Walking On Sunshine

Balanced mid gold bitch with straight front and neat feet. Good head with dark eye and pleasing expression. Already deep through chest and well ribbed up. Level topline held on the move, correct tailset, good bend of stifle and well let down hocks. Moved correctly away and back and with style and drive in profile. Well presented and handled. **Best Puppy**

2nd Joseph's Baradav Heart Of Gold (AI)

Another very balanced bitch with similar comments applying. Straight front with pleasing head, dark eye and pleasing expression. Good length of neck and adequate forehand, well ribbed with level topline, correct tailset and good bend of stifle. Moved correctly all through. Shown in lovely, well presented coat and well handled. Just a shade apprehensive today.

Junior Bitch

1st Middleton/Salvestrin's Fantango Poker Face

Quality bitch and balanced all through. Well proportioned head with lovely dark eye, good pigmentation and pleasing expression. Straight but standing a little wide in front, neat feet with good forechest and forehand construction and good depth of brisket. Level topline and correct tailset with very good bend of stifle. Moved out well with drive and ease - a picture in profile. Shown in lovely, well presented coat in good condition and carrying no excess weight.

2nd Goldshyne Kennels' Sandewood The Beez Kneez At Goldshyne (AI)(Imp NZ)

Very similar to (1) Nice head with dark eye and good pigmentation giving pleasing expression. Straight front with well constructed forehand and good length of rib. Tending to slope a little in topline today but correct tailset and pleasing bend of stifle. Well presented, carrying no excess weight and moved out well.

3rd Serngold Angelas Legacy

This girl was giving away a lot in maturity and not always showing off her best but, when relaxed, had a very pleasing outline. Pretty head and pleasing expression. Level topline, correct tailset and good bend of stifle with well let down hocks. Moved out well and fell into a lovely shape on the move. Carrying no excess weight, well presented and handled.

Intermediate Bitch

1st Middleton/Salvestrin's Fantango Do You Wanna Dance

Very balanced with a lovely, clean outline. Straight front but a little loose in elbow. Good head proportions with lovely dark eye and good pigmentation giving pleasing expression. Good length of neck with good forechest and forehand construction. Good depth of brisket and well ribbed with level topline, correct tailset, lovely width of thigh, good bend of stifle and well let down hocks. Moved a shade wide in front but used her quarters well moving with drive. Shown in good coat and hard condition. Well presented and handled.

2nd Parkridge Kennels' Parkridge Billie Jean

Another very balanced bitch with lovely clean outline. Feminine head with correct earset and gentle expression. Straight front with good length of neck, good length of upper arm and correct layback of blade. Level topline and well ribbed back with correct tailset, good bend of stifle and well let down hocks. Moved correctly away and back and steadily enough in profile. Shown in good condition, carrying no excess weight and well presented and handled.

3rd Murphy's Ch Taleyah A Lass From Ballymore

Clean outline with lovely head, eye and expression. Straight front with good length of neck and good length of upper arm but not quite the layback of blade. Well ribbed back and firm over loin with correct tailset and adequate bend of stifle and well let down hocks. Correct away and back and moved out well in profile. Well presented.

Res Neldner's Honiggold Mellow Yellow (AI)

Another lovely clean, well balanced outline outline of good shape. Pleasing head, eye and expression with correct earset. Good forechest with pleasing forehead construction, level topline, correct tailset, well let down hocks and nicely bent stifle. Moved out well but a little untidy behind today. Well presented.

Limit Bitch

1st Thompson's Chaleur U Are The One (AI)

Quality bitch, well up to size with very good bone and substance and balanced all through. Nice head of good proportions with dark eye, good pigmentation and pleasing expression. Straight front with neat feet, good forehead construction and well ribbed all through with level topline and correct tailset, good width of thigh, well let down hocks and very good bend of stifle. Moved out well and covered the ground. Shown in lovely coat, well presented and handled. **Best Limit**

2nd Serngold Maiden Over

Smaller framed bitch but a nice clean outline. Pleasing head proportions with kindly expression. Straight front with good length of neck, adequate forehead construction, well ribbed back, level topline and good bend of stifle. Moved out easily on a nice stride. Well presented and handled.

State Bred Bitch

1st Joseph's Gr Ch Baradav A Reason To Smile (AI)

Very feminine. Good head proportions with correct earset. Good length of neck and straight front with good depth of chest. Well ribbed with level topline, bang on tailset and good bend of stifle. Moved truly away and back and with a lovely stride holding her topline in profile. Shown in lovely rich gold coat. Well presented. **Best State Bred**

2nd Parkridge Kennels' Chaleur You Got The Look (AI)

Bigger framed bitch giving away 2 years at only 18m of age so understandably less mature but presented a very clean outline. Feminine head with dark eye, good pigmentation and a lovely expression. Straight front with good length of neck into level topline with balanced angulation. Moved out well carrying no excess weight. Well presented and handled.

Australian Bred Bitch

Very close class with two very nice bitches (1) scoring slightly on forehead construction. Not surprised on later reading to find that they are bred by the same kennel.

1st Middleton/Salvestrin's Fantango Sunny Side Up (AI)

Clean, balanced outline dark eye and kindly expression. Straight front with neat with feet, good length of neck and depth of brisket and correct front assembly. Good length and spring of rib with level topline, correct tailset, well let down hocks and good bend of stifle. Moved correctly away and back and on an easy stride in profile. Well presented and handled.

2nd Goldshyne Kennels' Fantango Say It With Style (AI)

Again another clean, balanced outline with lots to like. Feminine head with dark eye and kindly expression. Good length of neck and forehand construction good depth of chest and well ribbed back, correct tailset with well let down hocks and good bend of stifle. Moved correctly away and back and with enthusiasm in profile but just not quite the stride of (1). Well presented and handled.

Open Bitch

Two lovely bitches heading this class with (1) only scoring slightly on forehand construction.

1st Middleton/Salvestrin's Gr Ch Fantango Stack The Deck

Lovely clean outline and balanced all through. Well proportioned feminine head with gentle expression. Good length of neck into very good forehand construction with good forechest. Good depth of brisket and well ribbed both ways. Level topline with correct tailset, good bend of stifle and width of thigh with well let down hocks. Moved correctly away and back and on an easy full stride in profile using her angles to advantage. Quality all through and shown in full coat and good condition carrying no excess weight. Well presented and handled. **Best Open** and a worthy **Challenge Bitch** winner. Didn't put a paw wrong in the challenge taking **Best Exhibit In Show**

2nd Thompson's Ch Chaleur Say My Name (AI)

Another top quality bitch with similar qualities. Well balanced bitch with excellent bone and substance. Feminine head with kindly expression. Straight front with excellent feet, good length of upper arm but would prefer a shade more length of blade to balance. Good depth all through and well ribbed with firm topline and correct tailset. Good width of thigh with well let down hocks and good bend of stifle. Moved correctly away and back and with plenty of enthusiasm but just not quite the stride of (1). Shown in full, correct coat, very well presented and handled. Delighted to award her **Reserve Challenge Bitch** in very good company.

3rd Neldner's Ch Honiggold Elegance (AI)

Nice sized bitch with clean outline and pleasing feminine head with kindly expression. Standing a little out at elbow but straight legs and lovely neat feet. Balanced all through with level topline and correct tailset, well let down hocks and good bend of stifle. Moved correctly away and back but not holding her shape in profile. Shown in good condition.

Veteran 7+ Bitch

1st Thompson's Ch Chaleur Hubba Bubba

Super quality 8 year old with good bone and substance. Feminine head with lovely dark eye and pleasing expression. Straight front with neat feet and food forechest. Correct forehand construction with good depth of chest, good spring of rib, level topline which she held on the move and correct tailset. Good width of thigh and bend of stifle with well let down hocks. Moved correctly away and back and with reach and drive in profile. Shown in super coat and condition. Well presented and handled and pressed her kennel mate hard for the Reserve Challenge. A credit to her owner.

2nd Sommer's Ch Goldog Alpine Sapphire

Very different in type but balanced all through and belying her 11 years. Pleasing head and expression with lovely dark eye. Straight front with good depth through chest and moderate angulation both ends. Well ribbed with level topline held on the move and correct tailset. Moved out with style and enthusiasm and in excellent condition with her lovely, rich golden coat absolutely gleaming in the sunshine. A credit to her owner.

Open Neuter Bitch

1st Mitchell's Ch Neut Ch Beaucroft Faith In You And Me (AI)

Lovely bitch of quality and so well balanced. Good all through with lovely head, good length of neck and straight front, good depth of chest and spring of rib, level topline, correct tailset, good width of thigh and bend of stifle with well let down hocks. Moved correctly away and back and steadily in profile. Shown in good coat and condition. Well presented. **Best Neuter**

2nd Joseph's Gr Ch/Neut Gr Ch Baradav Noble Affair (AI)

Another very balanced bitch of good quality. Pleasing head with correct earset and lovely dark eye giving pleasing expression. Straight front with balanced angulation fore and aft, level topline held on the move. Moved correctly away and back and happily in profile. Well presented.

1st - Mitchells- Kiriell Highland Laddie, mid gold boy of very pleasing type, loved his gentle nature, super head and eye, good reach of neck and shoulders well laid, level topline, tail well set on, good turn of stifle, straight front with good bone and tight feet, nicely ribbed, happy boy on the move, rather loose on the move which is to be expected.

Puppy Dog

1st - Middleton & Salvestrins – Fantango Double Take, well grown young man of lovely quality nicely headed with dark expressive eyes go of would prefer better shoulder placement, firm level topline, good width of thigh and bend of stifle, good bone and tight feet, well off in forechest, ribbing of good length and shape, slightly long in couplings, shown in super coat and condition, moved with reach and drive.

Junior Dog

1st - Goldshyne Kennels – Goldshyne My Style, quality and balance sum up this super young dog, cracking in head and eye and lovely pigment, scores in neck and shoulder, firm level topline, excellent rear angulation, good bone and neat feet, deep in chest and well ribbed with short muscular loin, beautifully presented pale coat, expertly handled, outstanding on the move, I had no hesitation in awarding the RCC in very good company, well done and good luck with him.

2nd - Wallis – Boolaroo Hillbilly, pleasing for type and quality, lovely head and eye with good neck and shoulders, firm topline and well-constructed rear, very good bone and tight feet, well ribbed, moved a bit wide in front, very good condition and sound temperament, carefully handled.

Intermediate Dog

1st - Thompsons – CH Chaleur U Had Me At Hello (ai), well grown pale dog with very good substance, pleasing enough in head with dark eye and good pigment, adequate neck and shoulders, firm topline, well angulated in rear, straight front with good bone feet could be tighter, very deep in chest with good spring of rib and short muscular loin, shown in well-presented coat and lovely condition, moved ok but slightly loose in front.

2nd – Stapyltons – CH Giltedge Hans Solo, dog of good size and quality, nicely balanced and pleasing in head with dark expressive eyes and good pigment, well-constructed in forehand, firm level topline, good rear, well off for bone, well ribbed, lacking drive on the move, well presented.

State Bred Dog

1st - Thompsons – CH Chaleur Say I Will (ai), top quality male of lovely type and balance, plenty of substance, super head with dark eye, good length of neck into well-constructed forehand, firm level topline, good width of thigh and turn of stifle, straight front with good bone and tight feet, good forechest, deep in chest, ribs of good shape and length, muscular loin, shown in well-presented coat and lovely condition, moved well.

Australian Bred Dog

1st - Handley & Stephens – CH Giltedge Do You Like Apples (ai), mature and masculine male with an outstanding outline, just cannot be missed, balanced head would prefer a darker eye, good reach of neck and nicely placed shoulders, firm level topline held on the move, good width of thigh and bend of stifle giving strong driving action, very good bone and tight feet, deep in chest, well sprung ribs of good shape and length, short muscular loin, shown in well-presented mid gold coat and good muscular condition, moved out with reach, drive and style, expertly handled, delighted to award him the CC and later on BIS, very well done and thank you for bringing him.

2nd – Ohlrichs – CH Piarki Winstons Golden Ticket, dog of superb type and balance, loveliest of heads, dark gentle eyes, good reach of neck, level topline, balanced angulation, good bone and feet, nicely ribbed and short coupled, presented in beautiful coat and condition, needs to body up and when he does he will be bad to beat, giving away too much in maturity here today, lovely on the move and very well handled.

Open Dog

1st – Thompsons – Sup Ch Chaleur Hilfiger excellent quality, a picture standing, well balanced, lovely head and eye, good reach of neck would just prefer a bit more lay back of shoulder, level topline, good tailset, very good width of thigh and bend of stifle, good bone and feet, good forechest, deep and well ribbed, short coupled, shown in well-presented coat and very good condition, moved with reach and drive, well handled.

Veteran Dog

1st – Murphy's – CH Baradav Murphys Law, 9 year old male of superb type and quality he was a picture standing, so balanced and so comfortable in his stance I never saw him standing anything but lovely, the most wonderful head piece with dark expressive eyes giving such a gentle look, good ears and set, good length of neck fitting so well in to well placed shoulders, level topline, good width of thigh and bend of stifle, straight front with good bone well up on pasterns and very good feet, deep in chest and well ribbed, short coupled, shown in well-presented coat and super condition, excellent temperament, moved out effortlessly, a credit to his owner, very nicely handled, delighted to award him Best Veteran In Show

2nd – Thompsons – CH Demist Highway Of Hope, pale boy of good size, balance and type, nicely headed with dark eye, good reach of neck in to well-constructed forehand, firm topline, good turn of stifle, straight front with good bone, deep through the chest, ribs of good length and short coupled, moved out well, another well-presented dog from this kennel.

3rd – Williams – CH Haydengold High Hopes, very balanced with good head shape, has numerous good points but I just found him too much all through, shown in profuse coat. Well handled.

Neuter Dog

1st – Wills – Neut CH Savaneta Light The Way (ai) big lad carrying no weight, lightly boned pleasing in head, light eye, very good reach of neck, upright in shoulder with balanced rear, rather shallow in body, coat well presented, very well handled considering this boy was really enjoying himself which was lovely to see, super temperament.

Baby Puppy Bitch

Two really nice babies at different stages

1st – Wallis – Boolaroo Seabiscuit Slightly further on in her development, pretty , feminine head with dark eye and very good pigment, lovely neck and shoulders into level topline, well put together at rear, straight front with good bone and neat feet, body maturing nicely, moved really well with great attitude, expertly handled to advantage.

2nd – Stephens & Platts – Fetchnpoint Roll The Dice, such a super elegant and feminine young lady with lots of promise, sweetest of heads with dark eyes and good pigment, level topline, moderate rear angulation, lighter in bone with tight feet, again body maturing nicely, moved out well, well handled.

Minor Puppy Bitch

1st – Pattersons – Fernfall Summer Rains, mid gold, very good quality, excellent outline, lovely head and eye, scores in neck and shoulders, level topline, good width of thigh and bend of stifle, good straight front with tight feet, well ribbed back and short coupled, moved on a very good stride and with super drive all topped off with a well presented coat, handler certainly got the best from this one.

2nd – Bings – Goldverlia Aurora Skylar, glamorous quality pale coated bitch with much promise, lovely head and dark eye, good neck and shoulders, level topline held on the move, well-constructed at rear, shown in super condition, moved smartly, I feel that this bitch just needs a bit more practice to be sure of her surroundings and she will show better when confident, good luck.

3rd – Bourns – Bournbeau Blair In Tartan, mid gold, would not want her any bigger and slightly strong in head for me, good length to neck and adequate shoulder angulation, firm level topline which was held on the move, good width of thigh and bend of stifle, straight front with good bone and neat feet, ribbing needs to develop, short coupled, moved out really well, shown in beautifully presented rich coat and very well handled

4th – MacDonalds – Morningmyst Reason To Believe (ai), large framed bitch needs time to fill in, pleasing in head, balanced angulation, well presented coat, moved out well and well handled.

Puppy Bitch

1st – Hodges & Hodges – Camuka Walking On Sunshine, quality mid gold bitch, lovely for type and balance, very pleasing in head and eye, good length of neck fitting nicely in to well placed shoulders, level topline, good tail and set, good width of thigh and bend of stifle giving strong driving action, straight front with good bone and tight feet, deep in chest and well ribbed up, short coupled, moved really well, very well handled, very promising

2nd – Joseph & Josephs – Baradav Heart Of Gold (ai) lovely quality, super head and dark expressive eyes, good reach of neck and well laid shoulders, level topline, well angulated at rear, straight front and good bone, good spring of rib back to short couplings, shown in lovely coat and condition, moved out well but not quite so positive as 1

3rd – Williams – Lanjara Give Me Yr Answer Do promising type but not cooperating with handler, pleasing in head with dark gentle eyes, very good neck and shoulders, slight dip in topline, moderate rear angulation, good bone and feet, nicely ribbed and short coupled, unruly coat and movement erratic.

Junior Bitch

1st – Middleton & Salvestrins – Fantango Poker Face excellent quality, beautiful type, clean outline very feminine and so sound. Lovely head proportions, soft expressive eyes, excels in neck and shoulder, firm level topline held on the move, good tail and set, well-constructed at rear, straight front with good bone, well up on pasterns and tight compact feet, pronounced forechest, ribbing of good shape and length reach well back to short muscular loin, moved out with reach, drive and style, first class presentation and expertly handled, pleased to award her the CC and later RBIS losing out on maturity as one would expect to a finished male.

2nd – Goldshyne Kennels – Sandlewood The Beez Neez At Goldshyne (ai) (IMP NZ) this one was very close up to 1 as she has many of the same attributes, very similar in type and carries plenty of quality, soundly constructed and very feminine, the main difference was in the movement as she was lovely going and in profile but coming towards she was moving wide in front

Intermediate Bitch

1st – Middleton & Salvestrins – Fantango Do You Wanna Dance, quality, type and balance, super outline, excellent neck and shoulders, firm level topline, good width of thigh and bend of stifle, good bone and feet, deep in chest with ribs of good shape, short coupled, lovely coat and condition, sound effortless mover.

2nd – Parkridge Kennels – Parkridge Billie Jean, lovely type and balance with pleasing head and dark eyes, good length of neck in to well placed shoulders, level topline, well angulated rear construction, very good bone and tight feet, deep in body with good spring of rib and short coupled, moved with good reach and drive.

3rd – Neldners – Honiggold Mellow Yellow (ai), good quality, good head piece, scores in forehand angulation, topline rising to quarters, moderate rear, good bone and tight feet, deep and well ribbed, well presented coat, movement could have been better and carrying slightly too much weight, very attentive to handler.

4th Murphys – Ch Taleyah A Lass From Ballymore, really liked this lovely girl for type, beautifully presented, unfortunately she would not co operate with her handler so did herself no favours and I did not get the chance to see her looking her best a real shame.

Limit Bitch

1st – Thompsons – Chaleur U Are The One (ai), decent sized pale girl with plenty of substance and quality, good head and eye, good reach of neck fitting nicely in to well constructed forehand, level topline with correct tailset, good width of thigh and well bent stifles, very good bone and tight feet, deep in chest with ribbing of good shape and length, short coupled, moved out really nicely, excellent presentation.

State Bred Bitch

1st – Joseph & Josephs – GR CH Baradav A Reason To Smile (ai), pleasing in outline and head would prefer a darker eye, good reach of neck but rather upright in forehand angulation, level topline, well put together at rear, good bone and feet, deep in chest and well ribbed back to muscular loin, show in well presented mid gold coat.

2nd – Parkridge Kennels – Chaleur U Got The Look (ai), lovely head and eye, would prefer better angulation front and rear but she is balanced, deep in chest with good spring of rib, rather long in couplings, well presented and handled, moved ok.

Australian Bred bitch

1st – Middleton & Salvestrins – Fantango Sunny Side Up (ai), quality and balance, pleasing in head and eye, scores in neck and shoulder, level topline, good width of thigh and turn of stifle, straight front with good bone and neat feet, pronounced forechest, deep through the heart, good spring of rib, short coupled, moved out really well, beautifully presented and handled.

2nd – Goldshyne Kennels – CH Fantango Say It With Style (ai), close up in most departments, again super quality and balance, lovely head and dark eye, good reach of neck and well constructed forehand, well constructed at rear, straight front with good bone, deep in chest and well ribbed, short coupled, well presented and handled, moved lovely in profile and drive but her front action cost her here today.

Open Bitch

1st – Thompsons – CH Chaleur Say My Name (ai) top quality feminine bitch with outstanding balanced outline, lovely head with dark eyes, good reach of neck fitting cleanly in to well placed shoulders and good return of upper arm, firm level topline held on the move, good tail and set, broad thighs and very good bend of stifle, straight front with good bone and tight feet, deep in chest ribs well sprung and of good length, short muscular loin, very good reach and super drive from this stylish bitch, beautiful presentation and expertly handled, delighted to award her RCC

2nd – Middleton & Salvestrins – GR CH Fantango Stack The Deck, very good in outline, not quite the balance of 1, pleasing feminine head with dark eye well constructed throughout, excellent ribbing and short coupled with moderate rear, moved on a good stride, shown in well presented coat and good condition.

3rd – Neldners – CH Honigold Elegance (ai) pleasing bitch with nothing overdone, very feminine lovely head, well put together with good ribbing and short coupled, moved out well covering good ground, well presented coat and excellent condition, moved out well, nicely handled.

Veteran 7+ Bitch

1st – Thompsons – CH Chaleur Hubba Bubba, very glamorous, super quality and balance, lovely head with dark eye and good pigment, good neck and shoulders, firm level topline, very good width of thigh and turn of stifle, straight front with good bone and nice to see her so up on her pasterns tight feet, very deep in chest and well ribbed back to short muscular loin, superb presentation, very sound on the move.

2nd – Williams – CH Haydengold One Step Ahead, very balanced, pretty head and dark eyes with soft expression, scores in neck and shoulders, level topline, well angulated rear, deep and well ribbed, nicely presented, moved out well.

3rd – Sommers – CH Goldog Alpine Sapphire, dark coated bitch with a slightly strong head for me, lacked in forehead construction, level topline and nicely angulated rear, well bodied, in good coat and condition, moved out well.

Open Neuter Bitch

1st – Mitchells – CH Neut CH Beaucroft Faith In You And Me (ai), to me this bitch could have won this class with her beautifully moulded head and dark eyes with the most melting of expressions absolutely stunning however she also has excellent breed type and balance, excellent neck and shoulders a level topline and well angulated rear, straight front with good bone and tight feet, deep in chest and well ribbed, short coupled, lovely coat and condition, moved very well.

Best Neuter in Show

2nd – Joseph & Josephs – GR CH/ Neut GR CH Baradav Noble Affair (ai), pleasing in outline, balanced but is lacking in angulation front and rear, nicely headed with kindly eye, level topline, well ribbed and moved out well.
