1. Baby Puppy Dog.

1st Turner's 'Swifttreve River Dance' 5 months well boned baby with a delightful head and expression, dark eye, neat reach of neck into well laid shoulder, good body and spring of rib, super quarters, moved very well.

2nd Braithwaite's 'Brackendell My Valentine', At almost 6 months is well developed in body with good spring of rib, just preferred head and front angulation of winner, but has very good bone and feet, profuse coat, moved well.

3rd Harding, Goodall & Rammell's 'Savaneta One Good Reason' At just 4 1/2 months this rich gold baby has a pleasing head but needs time to come together and develop in hind quarters, a bit loose on the move (as one would expect at this age).

2. Minor Puppy Dog.

1st Goldsirius Kennels 'Goldsirius Drummer Boy' Super pale cream boy, just loved his head and expression, excelled in front angulation standing four square with legs under body, good tight feet and pasterns, firm topline which he held on the move, sound movement from strong quarters.

2nd Stapylton's 'Giltedge Southern Scally' Pleasing in head and expression, good reach of neck into well placed shoulders but preferred upper arm angle of 1st, good body shape and spring of rib, moved quite well.

3rd Braithwaite's 'Montego Carry The Flag' Lovely head and gentle expression, shown in profuse coat, good shoulders and body, well turned stifles, just needs to settle in movement, should do well in the future.

3. Puppy Dog.

1st Boldiston's 'Naragold Magic Of Darcy' Such a well balanced young dog and at this age is quite stunning in outline adored his head and expression, kind in eye, super angles front and rear, well developed body with plenty of heart room, strong quarters and well let down hocks, moved very well, at one with handler, I'm sure a future title holder.

2nd Goldshyne Kennel's 'Dream Max Grandmother's Prospect' Super mid gold showing a lot of promise, lovely chiselled head and skull, dark eye, super front and shoulders, firm top line, very good quarters, very sound on the move.

3rd Harrowfield's 'Trigolden Just Lincoln' At just six months was rather up against it in this class and had to give way to older puppies but shows great promise and should have a bright future. Super head with good dark pigment, well placed shoulders but needs to develop in quarters and is well balanced for age moved well.

4. Junior Dog.

1st Joseph's 'Baradav Flying Solo' 14 months, strong in head with good deep muzzle, very clean in neck and shoulders, well sprung rib's, firm top line, strong well muscled hind quarters, moved happily and with good drive.

5. Intermediate Dog.

1st Coleman's 'Alnclair Pit Stop Brock' Striking young pale cream dog with a super outline, maturing nicely, loved his head and gentle expression, good bone and catlike feet, strong in body and loin, correct tail set, moved with purpose and drive.

2nd Harrowfield's 'Ch Trigolden Luv To Tango' Nice youngster with a strong head and good deep muzzle, preferred the front angles of one but a nicely balanced dog, short coupled, a little lacking in coat, moved well.

3rd Joseph's 'Ch Baradav Goinplaces Attractive mid gold dog, super pigment, well made throughout but a little too heavy over the shoulders which spoilt his outline, good spring of rib level topline, moved well when settled.

9. State Bred Dog.

1st Scholz's 'Ch Goldjazz Lordov Therings' Stood out here for his overall confirmation, typical head and expression, super front and quarters, well made throughout moved well and well handled.

2nd Reimann's 'Ch Bournbeau Sir James CD QC' Pleasing in head and eye, good bone and feet, another that was carrying too much weight over the shoulders spoiling his lovely outline, moved OK, in super mid gold coat.

3rd Smith's 'Goldmartini Boston' Good male head, pleasing eye and expression, nice outline, very happy boy needs time to develop in body loin and quarters, moved well when settled.

#### 10. Australian Bred Dog.

1st Smith & Clark's 'Ch Goldfleece Knock On Wood' Of obvious quality this super young mid-gold dog excels in outline, very typey, with a most typical head and gently expression, excellent forehand with corresponding quarters, good spring of rib, correct tail set carrying the right amount of weight, sound driving movement with ample reach in front, at one with handler, Reserve CC.

2nd Parkridge Kennel's 'Ch Ambermist Grand Design' Mature pale cream dog, with a super head and kindly expression, excels in front assembly, showed well when settled, mature deep body, good top line, well bent stifles and strong hocks, moved with purpose and drive.

3rd Brown's 'Piarki The Perfect Star' Pale cream boy of good size with an outgoing personality, correct shoulders to adequate upper arm, well off for bone, strong in loin, correct tail set, would prefer more turn of stifle however he moved well.

#### 11. Open Dog.

1st Handley's 'Ch Giltedge Blackwatch' Appealing greatly for his overall balance, this boy really has the 'Wow' factor, eye catching as he entered the ring, well shaped masculine head without coarseness, strong muscular neck into well angulated shoulder/upper arm assembly, tight catlike feet, dead level topline, very well presented in pristine mid-gold coat, moved effortlessly with reach and drive, Delighted to award him the CC and later BIS.

2nd Fall's 'GR CH Tulzean Autumn Tango' Super pale cream dog with an impressive outline, excelled on the move, has great presence, lovely head and expression, darkest of pigment, well made throughout, mature body and strength in loin, just preferred breadth of quarters of 1st.

3rd Smith & Woodcock's 'Ch Stanroph Shared Assets (IMP UK)' Attractive young dog who has a balanced outline, pleasing head and expression, good shoulder, adequate upper arm assembly, good bone and feet tends to stand a tad wide in front, well sprung ribs, sound on the move, good drive from strong quarters.

4th Cooke's 'Ch Goldew Dream Weaver' Mid gold dog of good true type, well up to size, preferred shoulders of winners, has a clean outline, pleasing head with strength and a nice dark eye, moved soundly.

#### 12. Veteran Dog.

1st Harding's 'Ch Goldog Alpine Kodiak' Ten and a half years young, lovely old boy who could show the youngsters how it is done. Delightful head and gentle expression, amazing muscle tone and tight feet, just right in weight, strong quarters, well bent stifles and strong hocks, moved with style and drive.

#### 18. Neuter Dog.

Daffern's 'Ch Goldenfire Sir Gwilym Et' Lovely to see one at the grand age of thirteen and a half. Super mid golden boy, beautifully presented and really enjoying his day out. Kindly head and expression, good bone and feet, moved slowly and correctly, his condition is a credit to his owner.

#### 1a. Baby Puppy Bitch.

1st Coleman's 'Lahabrie Littlest Rebel'. At 5 months this pale cream baby is nicely balanced and has a pleasing head, good dark points, nicely boned, super reach of neck into well laid shoulders, compact body for age, neat quarters, moved well.

2nd Kelton's 'Goldstream Whatever'. 4 months mid gold baby with a delightful head, dark eye, sweetest

expression, well made and balanced for age, with good bone and tight feet, moved happily and confidently, at one with handler.

3rd Coleman's 'Lahabrie Little Princess' At 5 months, litter sister to winner and in the same mould, sweetest of heads with kindly expression, balanced in outline, a bit of a handful but with practice should do well.

#### 2a. Minor Puppy Bitch.

1st Goldsirius Kennels 'Goldsirius Dancing Rose'. Very elegant outline for 7 months, pale cream girl with a happy disposition, very balanced for age, well off for bone, correct front, level topline, strong quarters and tail set, moved well.

2nd Smith's 'Goldtreve Tinsel Time'. Similar in type to 1, loved her head and expression, reachy neck, good shoulders, needs time to develop in body and loin, good topline, well turned stifles, moved very well.

3rd Jenkins's 'Sovanna Golden Rebekah' 7 months, sweetest of heads, lovely dark eye, better trimming would enhance her well placed shoulders, dense pale cream coat, good legs and feet, moved positively.

#### 3a. Puppy Bitch.

A trio of lovely puppies.

1st Braithwaites 'Brackendale Diamond Lace' 10 months cream girl with a beautiful outline and very clean lines, pleasing in head and eye, blackest of pigments, excellent front and rear angulation, short coupled, moved extremely well.

2nd Fall's 'Dream Max Anja Parson (Imp Swd)'. Another lovely cream with a stunning outline, not quite as feminine in head as one, but is very well made throughout with good spring of rib, dead level topline, well bent stifles and well let down hocks, moved straight and true.

3rd Cooke's 'Goldew Que Sera Sera' Sweetest of heads and kindly expression, correct forehand well off for bone, good body proportions and quarters, should have a bright future.

#### 4a. Junior Bitch.

1st Braithwaite's 'Brackendell River Sonnet' 14 months is developing nicely, very pretty pale cream with an impressive outline, excels in forehand with super quarters to match, level topline, excellent head carriage, moved with drive front and rear.

2nd Handley's 'Giltedge Amelie' Lovely girl with an elegant outline, just preferred upper arm angle of 1 but has a very bright future ahead, feminine head, good dark points, nice body properties, short coupled, good quarters, moved happily.

3rd Scholz's 'Goldjazz Whatacracka' Very elegant, larger in frame than 1 & 2, very well made and has good balance, super reach of neck into correct shoulders, moved soundly.

#### 5a. Intermediate Bitch.

1st Joseph's 'Dobro Golden Slipper' Good true type, loved her head and kindly expression, well up for size, excels in forequarters, mature deep body, firm topline, with ample strength in quarters and strong hocks, in very good coat, so sound on the move.

2nd Moore & Frederick's 'Tiptree Tricmat Skilly' Very different in type to winner, good head, would prefer a slightly darker eye, very compact pale cream with a feminine outline, well sprung ribs, with short coupling, good tail set, moved well.

3rd Smith's 'Goldmartini Pretty Woman' Similar in size and type to winner but sadly lacking her best clothes today, has a pleasing head and sweet expression, good confirmation throughout, strong body and topline, moved well.

4th Parkridge Kennels 'Kaparla Legal Eagle' Nice head with good pigment, very nice shape, elegant neck into well

laid shoulders, good legs and feet, level topline, needing more depth in quarters, but moved quite well.


#### 9a. State Bred Bitch.

1st Mutch's 'Chantesuta Zamfyr Georgi' 3 year old, mid gold, a little strong in head for me but has a nice dark eye and true golden expression, well placed shoulders hidden under a little excess weight, however has a pleasing outline, strong hindquarters moves well.

2nd Wallis's 'Boolaroo Calamity Jane' Pale cream, sweetest of heads, very feminine throughout but too upright in shoulder, good bone and feet, moved OK.

3rd Goodall & Rammell's 'Ch Savaneta Fire N Ice. Rich gold with darkest of pigment, kindly eye, shoulders could be better, good body, movement a little erratic and lost topline on the move.

#### 10a. Australian Bred Bitch.

1st Stafford's 'Tulzean Water Sprite' A super, balanced, mid golden girl with very clean lines, pleasing head and expression, good spring and depth of rib, strong quarters and well let down hocks, correct tail set and topline held on the move, good ground covering movement. Reserve CC. 

2nd Goldsirius Kennels 'Ch Fantango Shall We Dance'. Elegant pale gold with a feminine head and gentle expression. Larger framed than one and a little longer cast but a very nice bitch with a super outline, moved very well.

3rd Knight's 'Nightsgold Strange Magic' 3 year old mid gold, pleasing head with a kind expression, shoulders OK but shorter in upper arm, good bone and feet, firm topline, short coupled, adequate quarters, moved soundly.

#### 11a. Open Bitch.

1st Turner's 'Ch Ambermist Grace Inmotion' My notes say 'this lovely mid gold bitch has all the attributes necessary to achieve top honours' later it was no surprise to me to discover she has her title. Totally feminine in head together with gentle expression and dark eyes, outstanding for balance and construction, correct forehand and corresponding hind quarters, dead level topline, strong in loin and body, moved as I had hoped for from such excellent construction, covered the ground with ease. CC.

2nd Braithwaite's 'Ch Montego As You Dream' Another soundly constructed pale cream girl with an eye catching outline, super head with feminine expression, excels in forehand, elegant reach of neck, good bone and feet, well sprung ribs, firm topline held on the move, moved soundly front and rear.

3rd Moore & Frederick's 'Ch Roddenberry Bright Stream (Imp UK)' Pale cream with a pleasing head and outline, good pigment, adequate front with good body proportions, level topline, strong quarters and well let down hocks, moved out well.

#### 12a. Veteran Bitch.

1st Smith's 'Ch Goldfleece Pie In The Sky' At seven and a half years this mid gold girl was presented in excellent muscle tone and condition, pleasing in head with kindly expression, dark eyes, very good bone, tightest of feet, correct in forehand, strong short coupled body, level topline, good strength and depth of quarters, moved with purpose and drive.

2nd Wallis's 'Gr Ch Goldog Alpine Gabriellai' At ten and a half this girl had to give way to a younger veteran but otherwise is a lovely exhibit and is also well muscled throughout for her age, loved her head dark eye and sweet expression, well placed shoulders good depth and strength in loin, moved soundly.

#### 18a. Neuter Bitch.

1st Goodall & Rammell's 'Ch Savaneta Almost Heaven' Four year old good true type, shown in excellent mid gold coat, sweetest of heads, nice dark eye, shoulders OK, good topline and body, moved soundly.
